## OTHER NOTEWORTHY ACTIONS

- Waiving of circulation tax and rubbish-collection tax during lockdown
- Promotion of public contracts with local businesses and self-employed individuals
  - Employment of over 150 workers for a variety of projects
- Aid to Can Blai Senior Citizen Residence, taxi drivers, and the Guardia Civil
  - Opening of a shelter on 15 March, 2020
- Social tariffs: Reductions of 50% for retirees, large families and NGOs on water taxes, rubbish-collection, summer school, etc.
